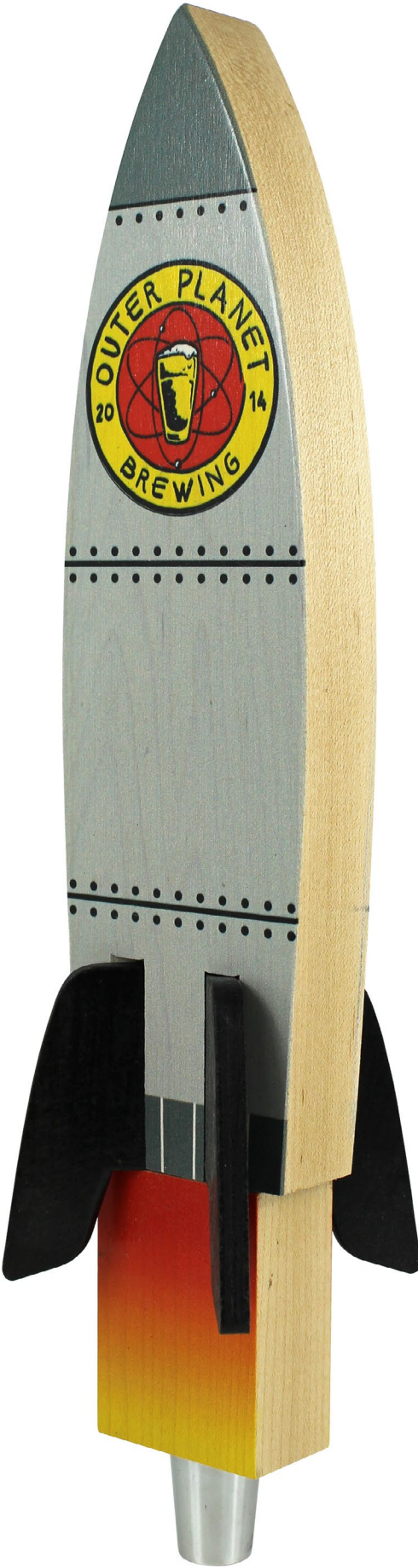

How do I get my custom tap handle?

The process starts in your imagination! What do you want your tap handle to look like? From there, you describe your vision to us. We will work with you to create a final product that fits both your ideal and our capabilities. This may include mock-ups such as the Outer Planet Brewing design to the right. Once you approve of the design, we go into full production!

What is the extent of your capabilities?

We love a challenge. So far, we have done custom

- CNC routing
- laser engraving & cutting
- inkjet printing
- color finishing
- hardware

Any combination of these can be used in your tap handle.

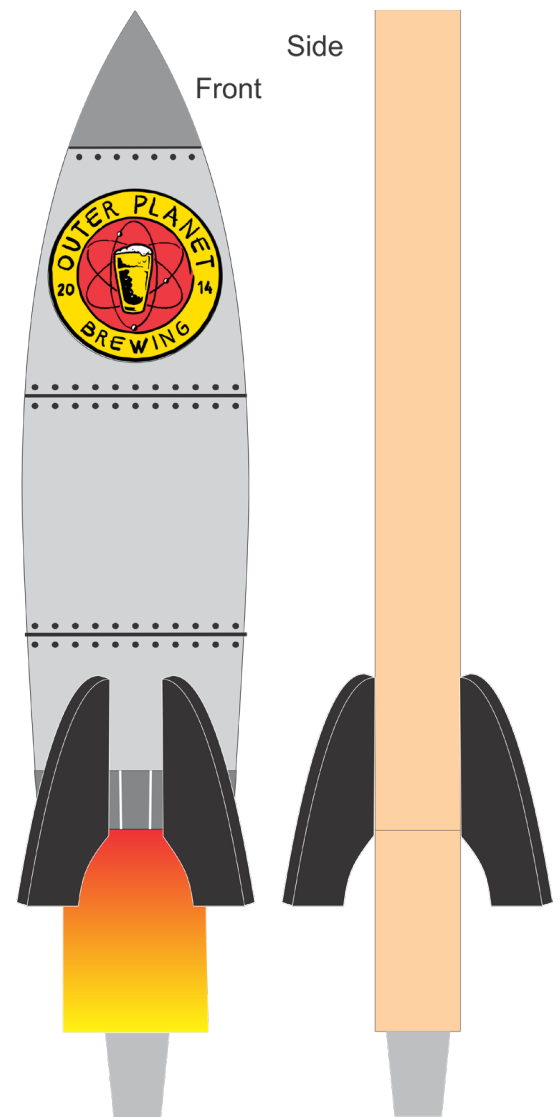
How much do custom tap handles cost?

The cost of a tap handle is dependent on several aspects.

1. Quantity - The more you order, the less each tap handle costs
2. Shape - Using a standard shape (seen on page 9) may decrease the cost
3. Customization - As the tap handle increases in complexity, so does the cost

What is the turn-around time?

Production time will vary, depending on quantity and complexity. If you need your handles by a certain date, let us know and we can try to complete production by that date. That said, orders can generally be fulfilled within 2-4 weeks.
